Warranted and tested

Dulux Alumi Shield™ and/or Steel Shield™ Project Warranties issued by Dulux Accredited Powder Coaters, contain project specific details and ensure that the project is coated in the right product to the correct standard giving you confidence of a great result.

Warranties are made up of a colour warranty (for colour fade and chalking), durability warranty (film integrity for aluminium only), and corrosion warranty (for steel only). They are only valid when applied by a Dulux Accredited Powder Coater to the warranty specification on recommended project types and conditions.

Standard Project Warranty

Residential projects less than 4 levels and non-habitable^ projects are eligible for a Standard Project Warranty. Once Accredited, Dulux Accredited Powder Coaters are required to submit powder coated production samples on a monthly basis in order to apply for and issue Standard Project Warranties.

Commerical Project Warranty

Residential projects greater than 3 levels and commercial projects are eligible for a Commercial Project Warranty. High rise residential and commercial projects are less sheltered from neighbouring buildings, raising their exposure and reducing their ease of maintenance, the product performance expectations and warranty testing requirements for these projects greater compared to other project types.

To apply for and issue Commercial Project Warranties, Dulux Accredited Powder Coaters must:

- 1. Gain warranty pre-approval of the product chosen to ensure the correct product is being specified.
- 2. Supply powder coated samples from the project which are then tested at our Australian and New Zealand technical centres to ensure they meet the strict standards required to gain a Dulux Alumi Shield™ and/or Steel Shield™ Project Warranty.

Accreditation levels

Dulux Accredited Powder Coaters are certified for applications on aluminium or steel, or both. This certification dictates which product and which substrate a Dulux Accredited Powder Coater is authorised to coat to warranty standard.
